



Rules:

1. No refunds or rider substitutions. Contestant must notify announcer stand of any horse substitution. No switching of draw positions.
2. 1 Minute time limit on all exhibitions. \$5 fine for each exhibition over 1 minute.
3. A rider may enter multiple times, as long as each horse and rider combination is unique. A horse may be competed on by multiple riders.
4. Contestant will receive no-time for knocking over a barrel, breaking pattern, or running out of turn.
5. 100% added money split evenly between the divisions. 90% entry fees jackpotted in High Stakes 3D. 75% entry fees jackpotted for Open 5D & Youth 4D. Payout based on standard BBR scale.
6. Boots are required for riders. Full western attire is not required, but all are asked to dress appropriately.
7. 5D Open format will be determined as follows: 1D - fastest time of race, 2D – fastest time plus .5 second, 3D – fastest time plus 1 second, 4D – fastest time plus 1.5 seconds, 5D – fastest time plus 2 seconds. 4D Youth format will be determined as follows: 1D - fastest time of race, 2D – fastest time plus .5 second, 3D – fastest time plus 1 second, 4D – fastest time plus 2 seconds. 3D High Stakes format will be as follows: 1D - fastest time of race, 2D - fastest time plus .5 second, 3D - fastest time plus 1 second.
8. Contestant must compete both Saturday & Sunday on same horse to qualify for average awards. Horses name must be listed on entry form. Any tie for awards will be determined by coin toss. Average awards presented immediately following Sunday race. Producer is not responsible for awards not picked up by contestant at that time.
9. Failure to answer 3 gate calls will result in an official scratch.
10. All re-runs are at discretion of arena director. A horse falling during a run or any tack malfunction will NOT receive a re-run.
11. Contestant must be pre-entered to be in first draw. Late entries will run after all pre-entries.
12. Open 5D, Youth 4D, and High Stakes 3D races will run concurrently. If a rider enters more than one race, they will make one run each day.
13. Youth 4D is limited to riders age 18 & Under. A contestant's age will be based on their age as of January 1 of the current year.
14. Books will remain open until the last 25 horses run each day.
15. All contestants and spectators are expected to conduct themselves in a sportsmanlike fashion at all times. Failure to do so may result in disqualification. Verbal abuse will not be tolerated.
